CHARACTER CONTRACT

Developing and displaying positive character values is very important at the MESI Camp.

Therefore, we expect our campers to agree to follow our MESI Character Code:

Campers are expected to:

- Be respectful of others' feelings and differences.
- Show respect and kindness to other campers and staff.
- Be honest with other campers and staff.
- Respect the property of MESI facilities and other campers.
- Demonstrate responsibility by being helpful.
- Do what I can to have fun, and to help others have fun, too.

The following behavior will not be tolerated:

- Inappropriate language (swearing, slang/negative words)
- Fighting, "rough-house" play or behaving in an unsafe or aggressive manner (hitting/kicking/biting)
- Stealing
- Bullying (physical or emotional)
- Vandalism or improper use of MESI equipment
- Disrespectful behavior
- Failure to follow directions repeatedly
- Running away from camp, MESI Administration, site coordinator, counselors and/or MESI staff

Failure to comply with these expectations will result in disciplinary actions as stated in the MESI Parent Handbook.
